Ms. Singh, beloved wife, mother, and lifelong softball enthusiast, tragically passed away five years ago on July 16, 2014 when she was taken hostage during a Stockton bank robbery and high-speed chase. Several family members, prominent community leaders, and other dignitaries will be on hand for the celebration of Misty’s life and the unveiling of the field’s new name in her honor.
